

SELF REVIEW POLICY

RATIONALE:

A culture of self review will enhance the quality of education for our students.

PURPOSE:

We seek to continually improve Long Bay College through an ongoing and deliberate process of learning how what we do enhances the learning and development of our students.

By identifying the aspects of our practice which work well and those which could be improved, we can transform our procedures and consequently improve the quality of education experienced by Long Bay College students.

POLICY:

1. We will develop and maintain an ongoing cycle of self review of all policies, plans, programmes, including evaluation of student achievement information.
2. A register of what is reviewed and when will be maintained. It is noted that in seeking a culture of review throughout Long Bay College, this register cannot be all inclusive.
3. The achievement of students will be reported to the Board of Trustees, students and parents/caregivers.
4. This policy should not be reviewed for another three years.

CONCLUSION:

Evidence of the success of this policy will come from:

- Improving student achievement.
- Improving co-curricular achievement and participation.
- High staff morale.
- High trust culture.
